Sister Margaret Motley is the co-founder of Miracle Deliverance Temple of Christ in Montgomery. Along- side her husband Pastor Aaron Motley, Sister Motley dreamed of a place in the heart of Montgomery's most troubled communities that could serve the needs of hurting impoverished people. The idea of the Miracle Center was conceived in the mid-1990s and in recent years, the work to bring that vision to pass is finally underway. Sister Motley served as a mentor, Sunday School Chief Administrator, Sunday School teacher, Financial Team Supervisor and Advisor with the Pastor's Staff. Her legacy includes being a homemaker, mother and wife. A graduate of Alabama State University, she went on to pursue



a career in business and financial management. Sister Motley made an impression as a leader in the church. She headed many fundraising projects, she counseled numerous married and single couples. Sister Motley was a minister of the Word of God, eventhough she did not want to formally acknowledge the call on her life. As her health began to fail in recent years, she was unable to work and serve as she did earlier. However, she was faithful to do what she could when she could. From her hospital bed, she would send messages advising the Pastor's staff or financial team on how to handle major projects. A true woman of virtue, a prayer warrior until the end.
